FROM BARCELONA AIRPORT

First option: Terminal 2

- 1.Take Rodalies train RN2 from Barcelona Airport Terminal 2 until Barcelona - Sants
- 2.Take Regional, Mid-distance or Avant train from Barcelona - Sants to Girona; in the station they can inform you of prices and times (goes from 6am to 11pm)
- 3.Take bus 42 in Estación de Autobuses de Girona (run by Sarfa company) until Palafrugell Estació d'Autobusos
- 4. Walk 15 minutes or take bus number 6 (1 stop) and walk 5 minutes until Alberg Solidança

Second option: Terminal 1

Take bus 1 from Barcelona Airport Terminal 1 direction Palafrugell until Palafrugell Estació d'Autobusos (run by Sarfa company)

1. Walk 15 minutes or take bus number 6 (1 stop) and walk 5 minutes until Alberg Solidança









TRANSPORT



FROM GIRONA AIRPORT



First option

- 1. Take bus number 5 from Girona Airport at stop named Vilobi D'onyar Aeroport Girona until Palafrugell Estació D'Autobusos
- 2. Walk 15 minutes or take bus number 6 (1 stop) and walk 5 minutes until Alberg Solidança

Second option

- 1. Take bus 601 or L-28 from Girona Airport until Estación de Autobuses de Gerona
- 2. Take bus 42 in Estación de Autobuses de Girona (run by Sarfa company) until Palafrugell Estació d'Autobusos
- 3. Walk 15 minutes or take bus number 6 (1 stop) and walk 5 minutes until Alberg Solidança
